



Online Trading

... getting started.

Starting an online shop is a great way of selling your products to a much wider market. Not every product can be sold in this way, but even if a small part of what you offer is suitable, it's worth considering. Remember though, that proper market research and preparation are just as important as for any other commercial activity.

Before starting however, there are a few things you need to beware of

1. What is the likely demand, and can you process the orders?
2. How often will the availability and/or price of your items change? This will have an impact on how (and how often) the web site will need updating.
3. How will the goods be shipped to the customer? Bulky, fragile or high value items will need special consideration.

There are also a whole bunch of rules and regulations relating to e-Commerce and 'Distance Selling'. These cover a range of issues, including:

1. Returns and cancellation policy. Your Terms of Business will at the very least need a check over, and revising if needed to ensure compliance.
2. Delivery costs – the customer MUST know these before committing to an order.
